Following the pandemic



Anxiety symptoms



Increased by 74%



Depressive symptoms >>> Increased by 57%

While people of different sexes and genders had more symptoms of anxiety and depression following the pandemic . . .



Women and nonbinary people experienced higher levels of anxiety and depression than men.
