Examining predictors of family roles and responsibilities, we found:



Men perform more traditionally masculine tasks, such as mowing the lawn.

Women perform more traditionally feminine tasks, such as cooking meals.

30-50 year-old people had a higher workload.

Age, gender, and ethnicity explained 41% of the differences in family roles and responsibilities.
